Tweede boosterprik tegen het coronavirus Second booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine

Dear Ghentian,

As a vaccinated 80-plus-year-old you will soon receive or you have received an invitation for your **second booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine**. This is an extra shot with the Pfizer vaccine that keeps your immunity level high. This is how you can make an appointment:

You live at home

- You have to make an appointment yourself. Schedule your appointment on **stad.gent/vaccinatie** or contact the City of Ghent vaccination line at **09 210 10 44**.
- You will be welcomed again by the staff of the familiar **vaccination centre Flanders Expo**, Maaltekouter 1, 9051 Ghent. We will receive you in comfortable surroundings and provide customised support if you have mobility problems.
- We will vaccinate on 31 May and 1 and 8 June. More dates can be added later.
- You live at home but you are not capable of moving independently? Ask your general practitioner about the possibilities of vaccination at your home.

You live in a residential care centre?

- Your residential care centre's staff will inform you.
- You receive your second booster shot on the premises. You don't have to do anything.

- You are unable to come to the prescheduled appointment? Make an appointment in consultation with your residential living assistant for the booster vaccine in **Flanders Expo**.
